- Students enrolled in the 38-hour program are required to take the 15 classes outlined in the table below. Included in those 15 classes are the 8-hour mandatory Drug & Alcohol and Safe Driving Practices classes.
- The 8 hour Drug & Alcohol and Safe Driving Practice Program (D&A) are Classes 7P/S or 7A, 8, 12 & 13
- A **parent/legal guardian is required** to attend Class 7P/S with the student if the student is 16 or 17 years old. Students 18 or older cannot attend Class 7P/S. They need to attend Class 7A which is only offered every other Saturday at 9:30 am.

****16 & 17 year olds cannot attend more than four hours of classroom on a non-school day, per DMV driving school regulations.**
